

REGULAR MEETING OF THE ALCESTER CITY COUNCIL

The Alcester City Council held their regular City Council Meeting on Monday, January 17, 2022. Mayor Haeder called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm with the following Council members present: Dave Larsen, Linda Talbott, Darla Reppe, Lukas Driesen and Cyndi Peeples. Also present during the meeting were Patricia Jurrens, Wanda Halverson, Lonnie Johnson, Riley Johnson, Chief Schuller, Gordon Richard, Vickie Larsen, and Heidi Austin. All stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Dave Larsen made a motion to approve the agenda; Linda Talbott seconded it. Five voted aye.

No Alderman Interviews.

For Public Input – Vickie Larsen addressed the Council with concerns of garbage cans, dome lids, public involvement, and a FOIA request for Flood Maps. Darla Reppe followed up with plumber for Alcester Bar. This concluded Public Input.

Heidi Austin, Brosz Engineering, presented information regarding Multi-City Chip Sealing project. The Council asked questions and Ms Austin provided information. A sample contract is being reviewed by Sam Nelson. The Council will review and make a decision at the February Council meeting.

Chief Schuller presented a quotation for a Rifle purchase from Buck's Gun Shop. Linda Talbott made a motion to approve the purchase of a AR 15 16" Barrel Rifle, Buck's Gun Shop, General Fund, \$975; Cyndi Peeples seconded it. Five voted aye. This concluded Police Department.

For Chairperson Updates – Street – Lukas Driesen stated he spoke with Lonnie and things are going good, snow blower worked great for the sidewalks. Cemetery – none. Water – none. Wastewater – none. Library – program at Library on Saturday and new books available for checkout. Golf Course – trees are trimmed waiting for pickup. Finance Office – none. This concluded Chairperson Updates.

Downtown Garbage Cans – discussion and review of formal quote from Snyder Industries for new cans for downtown. Dave Larsen made a motion to approve the purchase of (4) four new cans for downtown, 58 Gallon, Royal Blue, Gravity Latch, \$2,910.98 no logos at this time; Darla Reppe seconded it. Five voted aye. This concluded downtown garbage can.

For Finance Office updates – first day to circulate election petitions is Friday, January 28, 2022 and Cat/Dog licenses deadline is January 31, 2022. This concluded Finance Office updates.
